



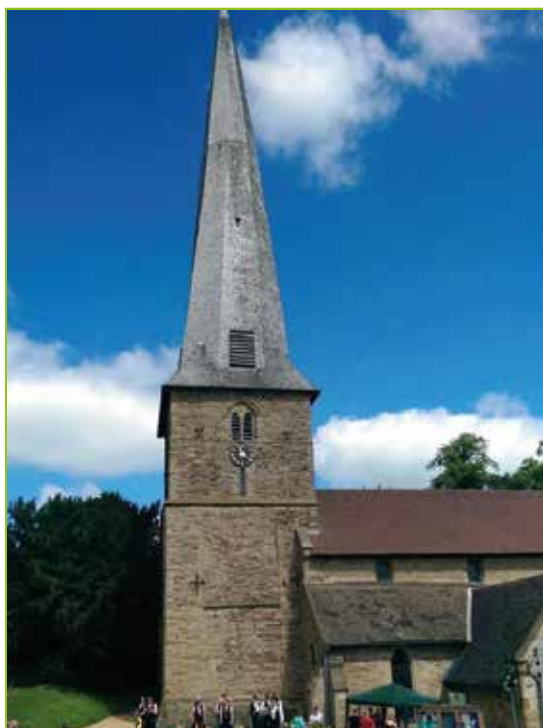
News letter

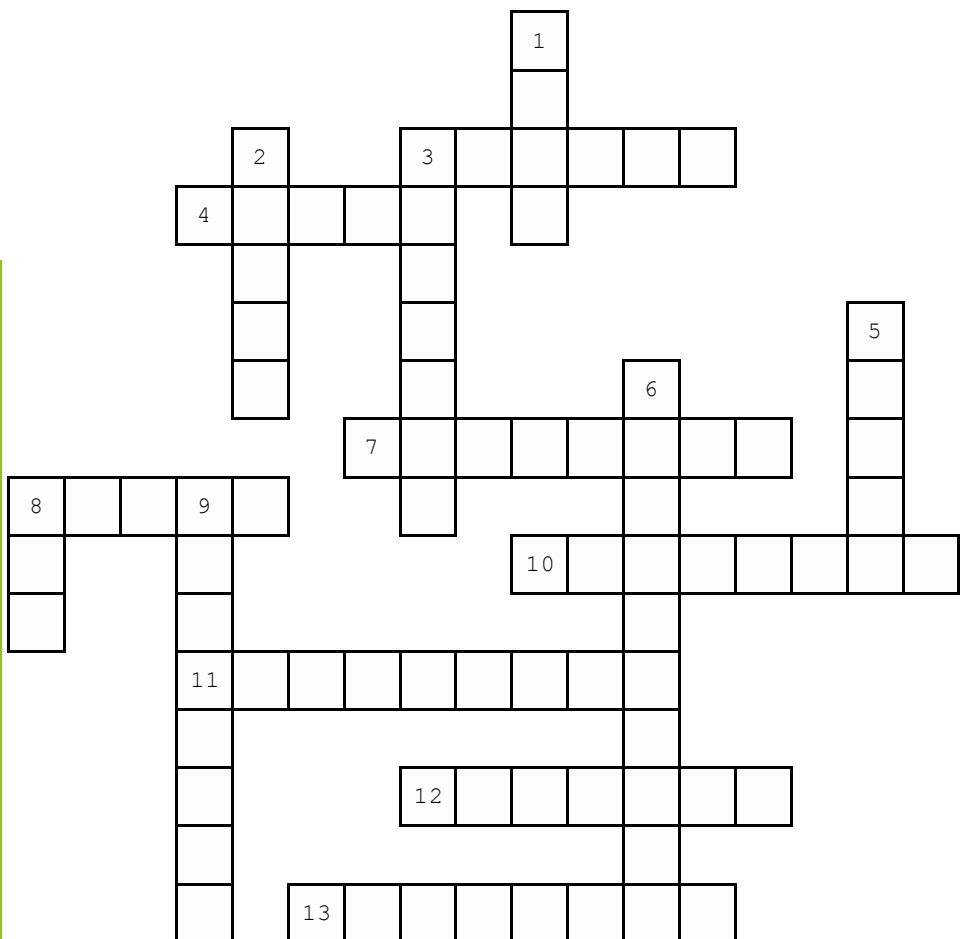
